I Pad and I Phone Technology Tip Email Customization

When you first begin using your I Pad every email you send with it has the signature "sent from my I Pad". This is a very easy thing to fix and then to add the signature that you would like.

Click on the settings icon

Click on the mail, contact, calendar section

Click on the Signature section

A note box opens and you can then delete the "sent from my I Pad" text and add any signature you would like such as your name and website address

Up above you will also see a Preview section and if you click on this you can set the preview to 5 lines which will help you get through your email quickly on your I Pad.

One of the issues with the I Pad is getting used to the virtual keyboard when trying to type or create documents. Apple has put in some keyboard shortcuts that make it much easier to get used to typing with it.

Double click the spacebar and it skips to spaces, puts a period behind the last word and capitalizes the next one automatically

Press on the .?123 button and hold it and you can then slide your finger to the key you want and it will jump right back to the original keyboard

Press and hold the comma button and it will switch to an apostrophe and add it

Save Yourself 30-60 Minutes Per Day Using Email Filters

The average person spends more than 30 minutes every day just sorting there email. That is 30 minutes you can get back by learning to use the filters that Gmail has built into it.
